Security and Safety Update

For more than a year we have been raising the level of our building and grounds security. Two years ago, we qualified for a sizeable grant from the Texas Workforce Commission designed to offset increased payroll costs due to COVID-19 and the safe schools initiative. As a result, we now have cameras, automatic and monitored door locks, and a security fence around the property.

Though the grant enabled us to buy all the equipment for the fence and gates, it was not sufficient to completely pay for the installation because of the increase in cost of installation over the course of the past year. Labor costs have increased, plus the demand for security fences around schools and housing developments is much greater than it was a year ago. The cost of installing the gates and equipment is now more than \$10,000.00.
